To mark up your paper for accurate registration

1. Line the paper up with the long line marked on the board's short side opposite the hinge and attach two small pieces of masking tape to hold the paper and act as 'hinges' as shown (hinges give you the chance to check and see how you are doing when burnishing).

2. Draw lines onto the back of your paper continuing the lines on the device as marked in red on this drawing. Be sure to mark all the lines clearly to make matching them up again easier.

3. Take care to match your lines exactly to the lines on device when returning the paper to the device for further printing.

The MDF insert can be replaced with strong cardboard or card as an alternative if you wish. However the insert needs to be thick enough to raise the lino to the height of the frame around it so that the lino is proud of the base frame (as it is when using the MDF insert). The lino can be attached to the insert using carpet tile adhesive if you want a permanent bond, or strong double sided tape if you wish to re-use the insert.
